**Come join your fellow golfing Rotarians and guests for a day of fun and fellowship at the beautiful Towa Golf Resort.**

Located on the Pueblo of Pojoaque only 12 miles north of the Santa Fe Plaza, Towa offers quality golf at an affordable price. PGA Tour Champion Hale Irwin and architect Bill Phillips of Tempe, AZ co-designed Towa. They utilized the natural topography and unique natural rock and indigenous piñon trees to create a magnificent, high desert golf course surrounded by the majestic Sangre de Cristo and Jemez mountains.

Three of the four nines currently are open. The Boulder nine, so named because of the amazing rock formations that frame it, also features the only island green in New Mexico (hole #4, 186 yard par 3). The first hole of the Piñon nine is a breath taking, 631yard, par 5. The Butterfly nine, at 3,332 yards, is the shortest of the three nines, but offers challenges for beginner and experienced players alike.

Towa offers professional instruction, rental clubs, a beautiful clubhouse and restaurant and fully stocked golf shop.

The 2010 Tournament will begin promptly at noon at the Towa clubhouse with a four-man scramble shotgun start for the 18-hole tournament. A box lunch will be provided. Cash prizes will be awarded to first place team and limited mulligans will be available for sale prior to the tournament. The fee for the day is \$100.00

Directions from Albuquerque/Santa Fe:

Go North on 1-25 (From Albuquerque take Route 599 around Santa Fe) to Highway 84/285. Continue North and take Exit #177 to Buffalo Thunder Road. Turn right at stop sign and follow directional signs to Towa Golf Club.
