David Cockerham – Espanola Rotarian



Dr. David L. Cockerham is no stranger to education. Cockerham was unanimously selected in June 2005 to begin a two-year contract as the Española's Superintendent. A graduate of the University of New Mexico, Cockerham received his B. S. in 1972 and M. A. in 1975. In 1992, Cockerham received his Ed .D. from Nova Southeastern University in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. Cockerham additionally has administrative certificates from Colorado State University and the University of Denver.

Cockerham began his career as a teacher teaching kindergarten through fifth grade classes, soon venturing into the administrative field as an Assistant Principal for the Albuquerque Schools in 1972. In 1981, Cockerham became Principal of the Stratton Public School system, becoming its Superintendent in 1987. Cockerham has additionally served as Superintendent for the Wooden Schools, Del Norte Schools, and Zuni Schools. Prior to coming to Española, Cockerham served as the Human Resources Director for the Littleton Schools in Colorado.
